Drum Lesson Policies & Agreement

This agreement outlines the terms and conditions for drum lessons provided by Sheldon D'Eith Drums. By enrolling in lessons, the Student and/or Parent/Guardian agree to the following policies:

1. Lessons & Fees

- a) Lessons will take place once a week, unless otherwise agreed upon.
- b) Holidays must be requested/discussed by the Teacher and Student/Parent/Guardian.
- c) Lesson fees are subject to annual review. Where Lesson fees are increased as a result of such a review, the Teacher shall give the Student at least two months' notice of such increase.
- d) An invoice will be sent at the beginning of each month including lessons for that month, the total must be paid upfront before lessons take place.

2. Cancellation Policy

- a) A minimum of 42 hours' notice is required to cancel a scheduled lesson. There is no fee for canceling.
- b) Cancellations made with less than 42 hours' notice will be charged the full lesson fee.
- c) Rescheduling lessons is not available. If the time slot no longer works please inform the Teacher.

3. Discontinuing Ongoing Lessons

- a) If the Student/Parent/Guardian wishes to discontinue lessons, a minimum of 4 weeks' written notice is required. If lessons are discontinued with less than 4 weeks' notice, the Student/Parent/Guardian will be liable to pay the fees for the remaining lessons in that period.
- b) The Teacher also reserves the right to discontinue lessons, in which case 4 weeks' notice will be given.

4. General Policies

- a) The Student/Parent/Guardian agrees to purchase any music equipment required for the lessons.
- b) The Student/Parent/Guardian is responsible for any loss or damage to any instruments, accessories, or music equipment loaned/borrowed by the Teacher.
- c) The Teacher is not liable for any injury, loss, or damages sustained during lessons or practice sessions.
- d) The Teacher must be informed of any relevant medical or personal conditions that may affect the Student's participation in lessons, including injuries, disabilities, severe allergies, etc.
- e) If the Student is under the age of 18, the Parent/Guardian gives full consent for the Teacher to provide instruction to the Student.

By continuing with lessons, the Student and/or Parent/Guardian acknowledges and agrees to the terms outlined above.
